Bible Lesson

MOSES AND THE BURNING BUSH 모세와 불붙은 떨기나무

Moses had grown up in Pharaoh's palace, but he knew that he was truly a Hebrew, just like the rest of the Israelite slaves. One day he went out to see the Hebrew people at work and noticed that one of the slaves was being badly mistreated by an Egyptian. Moses became angry and in a rage he killed the Egyptian. He knew that word would soon get back to Pharaoh about what he had done and he was afraid for his life! Moses decided to run away to the land of Midian where he lived as a shepherd for many years.

One day as Moses was out with his sheep he saw a strange sight. There in front of him was a bush, but it was no ordinary bush. This bush was on fire! Soon things got even weirder. Suddenly Moses heard God speaking to him through the flames! God told Moses that he was standing on holy ground so he must remove his shoes. Let's read from God's Word to hear what else the Lord said to Moses.

God had a big job for Moses to do! Moses didn't think he was good enough for the job God was giving him. In fact, he was downright scared! He was afraid that the Israelites wouldn't listen to him. He was also afraid because he wasn't a very good speaker. Moses made all sorts of excuses to God about why he wasn't the right man for the job.



But God promises to be with those whom He calls! Moses didn't need to be afraid because God would be with him no matter what. In fact, God would work through Moses to rescue the Israelites.

Moses was afraid that he wouldn't know what to say when the Israelites asked who sent him to rescue them. Let's read to find out what God tells Moses.

You see God is so big and so powerful that He can't have an ordinary name like Bob or Joe. When God says that His name is I AM He is saying that He has no beginning and no end. He is telling Moses, and us, that He is the one true God, and we can trust Him! It was hard for Moses at first, but he finally obeyed God's call to return to Egypt to rescue the Israelites from slavery.

Sometimes God asks us to do things that might be hard for us, but in the end they bring Him the most glory. It might be something like being kind to your brother or sister. Sometimes it's hard to obey God, but He always gives us the strength to do what He's asked us to do!
