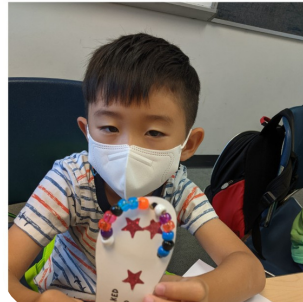

Bible Lesson

NOAH'S ARK GENESIS 8:1-9:17

Noah would tell the people, "God has promised to send a big flood that will come up, over the mountains. If you want to be safe, you must get on the ark." The people laughed at Noah. They didn't listen to God's words or obey Him. Finally, God said to Noah, "It's time to get on the ark. The flood is coming. Get on the boat, and the animals will come to you." Noah obeyed God and took his family onto the ark and the animals began coming, two by two. Noah's family waited six days but no rain fell. Finally, on the seventh day, rain began to fall from the sky. It rained and rained and rained. The water came up, up, up, higher and higher.
