Bible Lesson

THE TOWER OF BABEL GENESIS 11

After the flood, the animals spread out to find new homes. God had told Noah, "Spread out your children and grandchildren over the entire earth. Don't stay together in one place." God wanted people and animals to be everywhere on the earth, but some of Noah's grandchildren had a big "no" in their hearts. They didn't want to obey God. They said to one another, "Let's not spread out like God said. Let's stay together in Babel and build a big tower that will give us great power." They wanted to make themselves into a big city with a great name, without God.

The "no" in their hearts came from pride. Pride is when we think we are better than God. Do you think you are better and more powerful than God? That is just what we think when we say "no" to God.

They decided to build a great tower that reached up into heaven. They wanted everyone to think they were important. They wanted everyone to think they were special. What should they have done? They should have spread out. They should have wanted God to look great. They should have told everyone else how awesome God was. Their pride made them disobedient. They wanted their own way and not God's way.



God saw what the disobedient people were doing. God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit talked to one another and said, "Noah's grandchildren are disobeying Us. They want to built a great city and make a great name for themselves without Us. If We let them, they will sin in bigger and bigger ways. Let's confuse their words so that they can't understand one another. Then they will spread out over the earth." God changed the words that came from the people's mouths so that when they talked to one another, they couldn't understand what the other person was saying.

The words came out differently. People in one family couldn't talk with people in another family. The people were getting more and more frustrated trying to build the tower. They could not get their work done. Finally they gave up trying and moved their families away from Babel. The Lord spread them out over the whole earth, just like He had said. God always has the best plan. Now the name of the city is Babel.
