Bible Lesson

GOD CHOOSES JACOB OVER ESAU GENESIS 27:1-45

God had promised to make Isaac a big family, but he and Rebekah had no children. Isaac prayed to God, and God gave Isaac and Rebekah twin boys.

Esau was the oldest son. He had lots of red hair all over his body. Jacob was the second son. His skin was smooth. The oldest son normally would receive a blessing from his father, but God told Rebekah that this blessing instead would go to Jacob.

When Esau got older, he loved to hunt for animals. Isaac wanted Esau to receive the family blessing, even though God had said it should go to Jacob. Jacob liked to cook and help Rebekah, she loved having Jacob around and always remembered God's promise to Jacob.

When Isaac was old, he knew that it was time to pass on the family blessing, but he was blind. Isaac knew that God had said the blessing would belong to Jacob, but he didn't obey God. Isaac called Esau and said, "It is time to give you the family blessing. But first, go hunt for a wild animal. Cook it the way I like it and bring it to me."

But Rebekah overheard what Isaac said to Esau. She said to Jacob, "Quick! Go bring two young goats, and I will cook them the way Isaac likes. Then you can take his favorite food to him and receive the blessing."

Jacob knew it was wrong to lie, but he wanted the blessing. He put goat hair on his arms and wore Esau's clothes. He brought Isaac the food. Isaac knew something was wrong, but when he felt the hairy arms, he thought it was Esau. Isaac said, "My son, God has promised to make you into a great nation. Your brothers will bow down and serve you."

Soon after Jacob left his father's room, Esau came to Isaac with his favorite food, but Isaac was confused. "I have already given the blessing." When Esau found out what had happened, he begged Isaac to give him the blessing, but Isaac knew that God had wanted Jacob to have the blessing.

What Jacob did was wrong. But God is in control over everything. Long ago, he had planned to bless Jacob instead of Esau, and that is exactly what happened. We can be glad that God is in control of everything that happens and that He always does what is right and good.
