JONAH WARNED OF GOD'S JUDGMENT JONAH 1-4

God told the prophet Jonah, "Go to the great city of Nineveh. Tell them to stop doing evil things." But Jonah did not want to go to Nineveh.

So Jonah got on a boat heading the other way. God sent a terrible storm.

Jonah told them to throw him into the sea. When they did, the storm stopped. God sent a big fish to swallow Jonah, and Jonah was in the belly of the fish for three days and three nights. Jonah prayed and thanked God for sending the fish to save him.

Then the fish vomited Jonah onto dry land. He walked into the city shouting God's message: "In 40 days, Nineveh will be destroyed!" The people turned from their evil ways. Even the king repented. God decided not to destroy Nineveh.

Jonah made a shelter outside the city and waited to see what God would do. God taught Jonah a lesson. First, God provided a plant to shade Jonah from the sun. But the next day, God sent a worm. The worm made the plant die. Then God sent a dry east wind. Jonah was so hot, and he got so mad. God said, "You cared about the plant, but you did not take care of it or make it grow. It only lasted one day. Nineveh is a big city with thousands of people. I created them and care about them. Aren't they and the animals in the city more important than a plant?"
