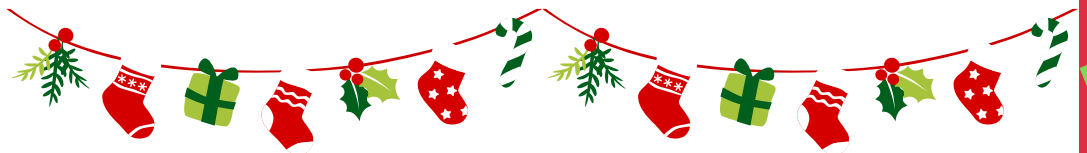

## Bible Lesson

JACOB AND ESAU  
GENESIS 27:1-45



God promised Isaac a large family, but he and Rebekah had no children. Isaac prayed, and God gave them twin boys. Esau was born first, with red hair covering his body, and Jacob was born second, with smooth skin. Normally, the oldest son received a special blessing, but God told Rebekah that Jacob would receive it instead.

As they grew, Esau loved hunting, and Isaac favored him, hoping he would get the blessing. Jacob, quieter and more home-loving, liked cooking and helping Rebekah, who remembered God's promise to him.

When Isaac grew blind with age, he decided to pass on the blessing to Esau. He asked Esau to hunt and prepare a meal for him first. But Rebekah overheard and knew God's plan. She quickly told Jacob to bring two goats, and she would cook them for Isaac. Then Jacob could take the meal to Isaac and receive the blessing.

Jacob was afraid Isaac would recognize him and get angry since Esau was hairy and he was smooth-skinned. Rebekah, though knowing lying was wrong, helped Jacob deceive Isaac. She told him to wear goat fur and Esau's clothes to make him seem like Esau. Jacob, desiring the blessing, obeyed. When Isaac felt Jacob's hairy arms, he thought it was Esau and gave him the blessing, saying Jacob would become a great nation and have power over his brothers.

Soon after, Esau returned with his meal, expecting the blessing. Isaac was confused and realized he had already given it to Jacob. Esau cried and begged for a blessing, but Isaac knew God had intended for Jacob to receive it.

What Jacob did was wrong, but God's plan was still fulfilled. Even when we make mistakes, God is in control and always does what is right.
