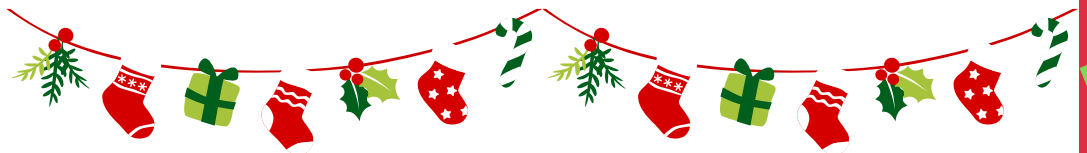

## Bible Lesson

### A WIFE FOR ISAAC GENESIS 24-25



Abraham lived many years. Before he died, he wanted to find a wife for his son Isaac. He asked his best servant to find Isaac a wife—not from the Canaanites who lived near them, but from his own people.

The servant took 10 camels with him on the journey to look for Isaac's wife. When the servant arrived, he stopped with the camels at a well outside of a town. The servant prayed to God. He said, "When the young women come to draw water, I will say 'May I have a drink, too?' If one of the women says, 'Drink, and I'll also draw water for your camels,' let her be the woman you have chosen for Abraham's son Isaac."

Before the servant had finished his prayer, Rebekah walked up to the well with a jug on her shoulder. She was not married, and she was part of Abraham's people. The servant said, "Please let me have a little water from your jug." Rebekah replied, "Drink, and I'll also draw water for your camels." God had answered the servant's prayer; this was the woman God had chosen!

The servant gave gifts to Rebekah—a gold ring and two gold bracelets—and the servant knelt and worshiped God.

They went to Rebekah's house, where the servant met her father and her brother. They agreed with Rebekah that she should be Isaac's wife. The servant and Rebekah returned to Canaan. Isaac loved Rebekah, and she became his wife.
