Bible Lesson

WE ARE GOD'S TEMPLE 1 CORINTHIANS 3:16

Paul was a follower of Jesus who shared about Him in Corinth. He built the church and taught the people about Jesus.

He later learned that there were many problems in the church, and people weren't keeping the laws from God like they should. He wrote a letter to them, telling them to make better choices.

And we can do that only when we walk with God.
