
1. Collect Talents. 달란트를 모아주세요.

Bible Lesson

GOD PROVIDED FOR HIS PEOPLE EXODUS 15-17

God led His people to the wilderness. The people traveled for three days but there was nothing to eat or drink. The people grumbled and complained to Moses. They said, "If only we had died in Egypt! We had all the meat and bread we wanted there!"

Moses and Aaron gathered all the people and said, "Tonight the Lord will give you meat to eat, and in the morning you will eat bread until you are full." That night, quail covered the whole camp, and the Israelites were able to eat meat. In the morning, God sent food from heaven called Manna.

Moses told the Israelites to gather only as much manna as each person needed to eat for the day and not to save any for the next day. If anyone became greedy and tried to keep more food than they needed, the bread would spoil and people couldn't eat it. 모세는 이스라엘 백성들에게 딱 그날 먹을만큼의 양식만 모으라고 했 어요. 그 중 어떤 사람이 욕심을 부려 다음날것까지 음식을 보으면 금방 음식이 상해서 먹지 못하게 되었어요. 하나님은 백성들에게 그날의 양식 을 정확히 아시고 그만큼을 그들에게 주셨어요.
