Bible Lesson

THE BRONZE SNAKE NUMBERS 21:4-9

Moses and the Israelites traveled in the wilderness on a long journey. The people were impatient, and they complained. "Why did you lead us into the wilderness? We are going to die here.

God responded by sending venomous snakes that bit the Israelites. Many of the people died.

The Israelites went to Moses and said, "Please talk to God for us. Ask Him to take away the snakes."

So Moses spoke to God for the people. God told Moses what to do: "Make a snake image and put it on a pole. When anyone who is bitten looks at it, he will recover."

Moses did what God said. He made a bronze snake and mounted it on a pole. Whenever someone was bitten, that person looked at the bronze snake and healed.

Just how the bronze snake was mounted on the pole, Jesus died on the cross for us. Whoever looks at Jesus and believes in him, will be forgiven and receive eternal life.
