# Bible Lesson

## THE PEOPLE BUILT THE TABERNACLE EXODUS 35:4-40:38

Moses told the Israelites "Bring your offerings to build the tabernacle!" gold, silver, and bronze; blue, purple, and scarlet yarn; fine linen and goat hair; animal skins; wood; oil; spices; and gemstones. The people kept bringing, and Moses finally said, "They are bringing more than enough."

Bezalel, Oholiab, and all the other skilled craftsmen came together to build the tabernacle

The tabernacle had 10 long curtains made out of linen. Eleven curtains made out of goat hair formed a tent over the tabernacle. Inside the tabernacle, the people made a veil.

They made a wooden box covered in gold called an ark, a table, a lampstand, and many other parts.

Aaron put on special holy garments, and Moses anointed him to be priest.

If the cloud covered the tabernacle, the people would stay where they were. When the cloud lifted from the tabernacle, the Israelites would move and take the tabernacle with them.

모세는 이스라엘 백성들에게 장막을 지을 예물을 가져오라고 하였어요. 청색, 자색, 홍색 실과 가는 베실, 염소털, 동물의 가죽과, 아카시아나무, 기름, 향품, 그리고 그 밖의 보석들을 가져오라고 했어요. 사람들은 계속 해서 예물을 가져왔고 모세는 이제 예물이 충분히 모였다고 말하였어요.

브사렐과 오홀리압과 같이 성막을 짓는데 유능한 자들이 모여 성막을 짓기 시작했어요.

성막은 열폭의 베실로 만들어졌어요. 그리고 열한 폭의 염소털로 성막 덮개를 만들었어요. 그리고 성막안에는 휘장(veil)을 만들었어요.

그리고 휘장 너머에는 금으로 만든 법궤와, 차림상과, 등대 등이 있었어요. 법궤 안에는 모세가 받은 십계명이 들어있었어요.

아론은 하나님께서 명령하신대로 거룩한 옷을 입고 제사장이 되었어요.

구름이 성막위에 떠오를때면 사람들은 성막을 가지고 움직였고, 구름이 성막위에 떠오르지 않을때면 그 자리에 머물렀어요.
