Bible Lesson

NEHEMIAH REBUILT THE WALLS NEHEMIAH 1-7

Some of God's people went home to Judah, but some of them stayed in Babylon. Nehemiah stayed and worked for the king of Persia. One day, some men came from Judah. Nehemiah asked, "How are God's people doing in Jerusalem?" The men had bad news: "The people are in trouble. The walls around Jerusalem are broken down, and the gates are burned down."

Nehemiah sat down and cried. Then he spent time praying and fasting. The king noticed Nehemiah and asked, "What's wrong? Why are you sad? Nehemiah said, "The city where my ancestors are from is destroyed and ruined." The king sent Nehemiah to Jerusalem. Nehemiah led the people to start rebuilding the walls and gates. The workers put in doors, bolts, and bars. All around the city, people worked hard to repair the walls. But some people weren't happy that Jerusalem's walls were being rebuilt. Some men who lived nearby made a plan to attack them and stop their work.

God's people prayed and chose men to guard the walls all day and all night. Nehemiah reminded the people that God

was with them. "Don't be afraid," he said. "God is great and powerful! Be ready. If our enemies attack us, God will fight for us!" So God's people went back to work. Some men had to work with one hand and held a weapon in the other. In just 52 days, the wall was complete! The gates were repaired, and the wall was restored!
