Bible Lesson

JESUS WAS TEMPTED MATTHEW 4; LUKE 4

After Jesus was baptized, the Holy Spirit led Him into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. Jesus did not eat for 40 days and 40 nights and prayed. When those days were over, Jesus was hungry. Then the devil, who tempts people to sin, came up to Jesus. He said, "If You are really God's Son, prove it. Tell these stones to become bread." Instead of listening to the devil, Jesus chose to trust God to meet His needs. Jesus said, "God's Word says that man must not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of God!"

The devil tempted Jesus again. He took Jesus to the top of the temple in Jerusalem and said, "If You are really God's Son, prove it. Jump off this temple and trust God to protect You." Jesus knew the devil's command was foolish. Jesus reminded him, "God's Word also says, do not test the Lord your God." Finally, the devil took Jesus to a high mountain.
