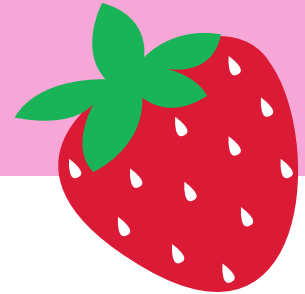

2. QTin Daily BIBLE Reading 성경읽기표

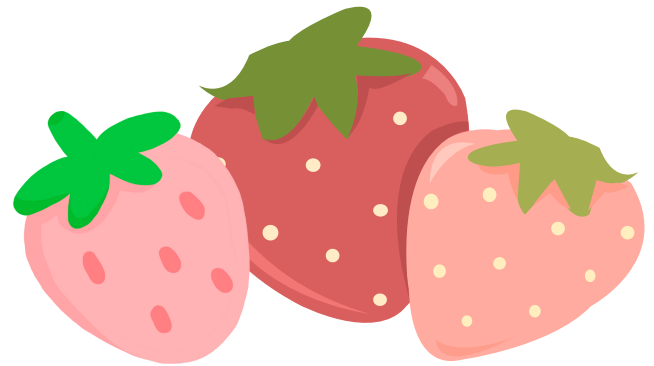
Please mark the calendar with the days that you and your child read the bible together or had QT and send it to your teacher by 04/28. (To qualify you must read it for at least 15 days!)

Bible Lesson

THE CHURCH SPREAD OUT. ACTS 8

An angel of the Lord told Philip, a follower of Jesus, to go to a desert road between Jerusalem and Gaza. So Philip went. On the road, there was a man from Ethiopia. He was an important official to the queen of Ethiopia.

He sat in his chariot, reading aloud the words of the prophet Isaiah. The Holy Spirit told Philip to go to the chariot, so Philip ran up to it. "Do you understand what you are reading?" Philip asked the man. The official replied, "How can I, unless someone explains it to me?" He invited Philip into his chariot, and Philip sat with him.

The official was reading these words from Isaiah: "He was led like a sheep. He was treated unfairly, and His life is taken away." The official asked, "Was Isaiah talking about himself or someone else?" Isaiah was talking about the Messiah, so Philip began to tell the man the good news about Jesus.

As they traveled down the road, the official asked "What would keep me from being baptized?" Then the official told the chariot to stop. He and Philip went down into the water, and Philip baptized him.
