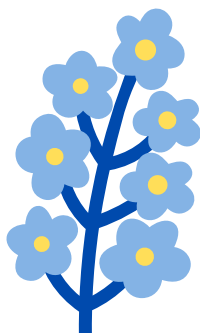

# Bible Lesson

## JOSHUA CHALLENGED THE PEOPLE JOSHUA 22-24

Now Joshua was getting old. He gathered all the people of Israel because he had some important things to say to them. "You have seen everything the LORD your God has done. He has fought your battles for you." He also said to obey God's word and love him and obey him always.

Joshua reminded the people about the things God had done in the past. God had called Abraham and had given him a son, Isaac. God had sent Moses to rescue God's people from Egypt and helped them to safely cross the Red Sea.

Joshua commanded the people, "Fear the LORD and worship Him. As for me and my family, we will worship the LORD."

The people replied, "We will not abandon the LORD! We will worship the LORD!"

Joshua made a covenant with the people. He wrote it down and also set up a large stone under an oak tree.

Joshua said, "This stone will remind you to always serve the lord.
