## THE PEOPLE KEPT SINNING JUDGES 2

God had led the Israelites out of Egypt, and He was with them as Joshua led them into the promised land of Canaan.After Joshua and the older generation of Israelites died, the Israelite children grew up and did not remember God or everything God had done for them.

The Israelites disobeyed God and worship the false gods. They forgot about the one true God.

God was angry. He let an enemy king take over the Israelites, and They suffered greatly because of that king.

The people would obey God as long as the judge was alive.

God raised up a judge but when the judge died, the Israelites would turn away from God and the cycle would begin again: They sin, God gets angry, they cry out to God, God saves them by sending a judge, and they would fall into sin again. All of this happened again and again.
