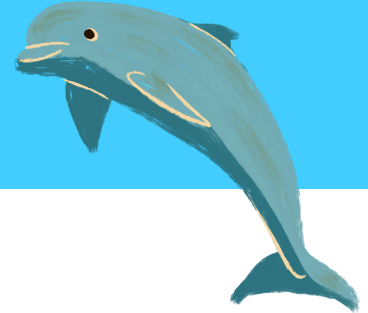

### DEBORAH AND BARAK JUDGES 4-5

God's people again did what was evil in God's eyes. As a consequence, they were captured by King Jabin and Sisera and the israelites had a very difficult life because of them.

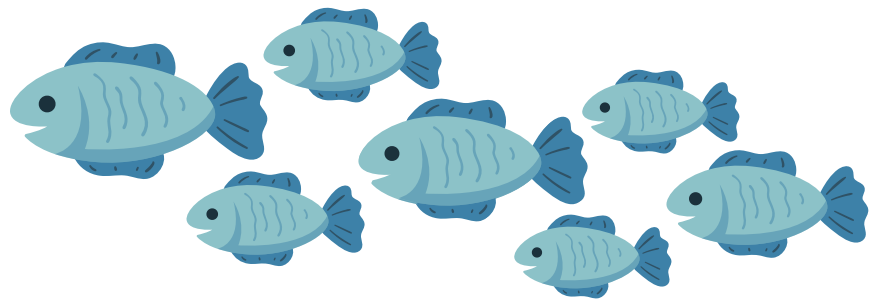
After 20 years of being treated badly by King Jabin, the Israelites cried out to the Lord for help.

God sent Deborah, a judge, to lead and help them. Deborah would sit under a palm tree and listen to the people's problems.

She called for Barak, a leader of Israel's army, and said, "God has commanded you to take the army to fight against Sisera! He has promised to hand you the victory." Barak said, "I will go if you go with me. If you don't go with me, I won't go."

"I will gladly go with you," Deborah replied.

Barak and Deborah gathered ten thousand men from Israel and attacked Sisera and his troops.



A big rainstorm came, and the river flooded. Their chariots got stuck in the mud, and they couldn't move! The soldiers got scared and started running away.

Deborah and Barak sang a song of praise to God for the victory: "Lord, may all your enemies perish just as Sisera did. But may those who love God Be like the rising of the sun in its strength." The Israelites had peace for the next 40 years.
