
## Bible Lesson

GIDEON
JUDGES 6-8

The Israelites continued to do what was evil in the sight of the Lord. So, the Lord handed them over to the Midianites, who destroyed the Israelites' crops and took their livestock.

The angel of the Lord appeared to a man named Gideon and said, "The Lord is with you, brave warrior. I am sending you to rescue My people from Midian." "But how can I do that?", asked Gideon. "I am from the weakest family in Israel, and I am the youngest man in my family." God said, "I will be with you, and you will have victory."

Gideon said to God, "I will put a wool fleece on the ground. If in the morning, there is dew on the fleece, but the ground is dry, then I will know that you will give Israel victory." When he woke, the fleece was wet, and the ground was dry.
