Bible Lesson

GOD USED SAMSON JUDGES 13-16

One day, the angel of the LORD spoke to a man and his wife. The angel said that they would have a son, and their son would save God's people from the Philistines. And God had special instructions for their son: He should never cut his hair.

The couple had a baby boy, and they named him Samson. God made Samson strong.

One day, Samson and his parents were heading somewhere and a lion jumped out and Samson killed the lion.

Samson killed a lion with his bare hands!

Later Samson fell in love with a woman named Delilah. God had commanded the Israelites not to marry women who did not worship God, but Samson did not obey God's word, and he did what he desired.
