Bible Lesson

PEOPLE REJECTED JESUS LUKE 4

Jesus went to the town of Nazareth. He traveled all around, teaching people about God. One day, Jesus went to the synagogue in Nazareth. The synagogue was a special building where Jews met together to pray, worship, and learn about God's word.
