# Bible Lesson

## GOD GAVE SOLOMON WISDOM 1 KING 2-3

David was the king of Israel for many years. When David died, his son Solomon became the king of Israel.

One night, God appeared to Solomon in a dream. God said, "Solomon, ask for anything you want, and I will give it."

Solomon did not ask to be rich or to have a long life. Solomon wanted to be a good king, so he asked for something even better. Solomon prayed, "God, I am young, and I do not know very much about being a king. Please make me wise and obedient to You. Help me know the difference between right and wrong. Help me lead Your people well."

God was happy with Solomon's request. God said, "I will give you wisdom. I will make you more wise and understanding than anyone who has ever lived. No one in the future will ever be as wise as Solomon."

God also said, "Because you asked for wisdom, I will also give you what you did not ask for: long life, riches, and honor. You will be greater than any other king during your lifetime." Then Solomon woke up. He praised God and offered sacrifices to worship Him.
