Bible Lesson

GOD IS GOOD TO GIVE MERCY LUKE 18

Jesus told a story to some people who looked down on others. These people thought they were better than everyone else. Jesus wanted to teach them a lesson.

"Two men went into the temple to pray. One man was a Pharisee, or a religious leader, The other man was a tax collector," Jesus said. Many people did not like tax collectors.

Jesus said, "The Pharisee stood by himself and prayed, 'God, I thank You that I am not greedy, dishonest, and unfaithful like other people. I am glad I am not like that tax collector. I fast two days a week and tithe.'

"The tax collector stood far away. He did not even lift up his head because he was sorry for the things he had done. The tax collector pounded on his chest and said, 'Have mercy on me, God! I am a sinner!'"

Jesus explained that God was happy with the tax collector, and He forgave him. But God was not happy with the Pharisee.

그런데 새리는 저 먼발치에 서서 기도했어요. 그는 고개를 들지도 못했어요. 하나님 앞에 자신의 죄가 너무나 부끄러웠기 때문이에요. 새리는 가슴을 치며 눈물을 흘리며 기도했어요. "저를 불쌍히 여겨주세요. 저는 죄인이에요."

예수님께서서는 하나님께서 새리를 기뻐하셨다고 말씀하셨어요. 그리고 새리를 용서하셨어요. 하지만 하나님은 바리새인을 기뻐하지 않으셨어요.
