I want to remember this passion week, the love and the suffering that you endured. You walked the life of faith and obedience to the Father. Help me to think about the pain and the death that you endured.

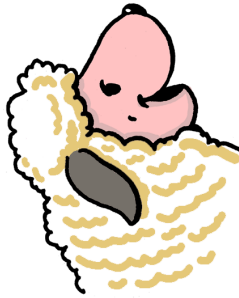
You loved me so much that you gave your life for me.

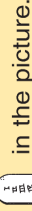

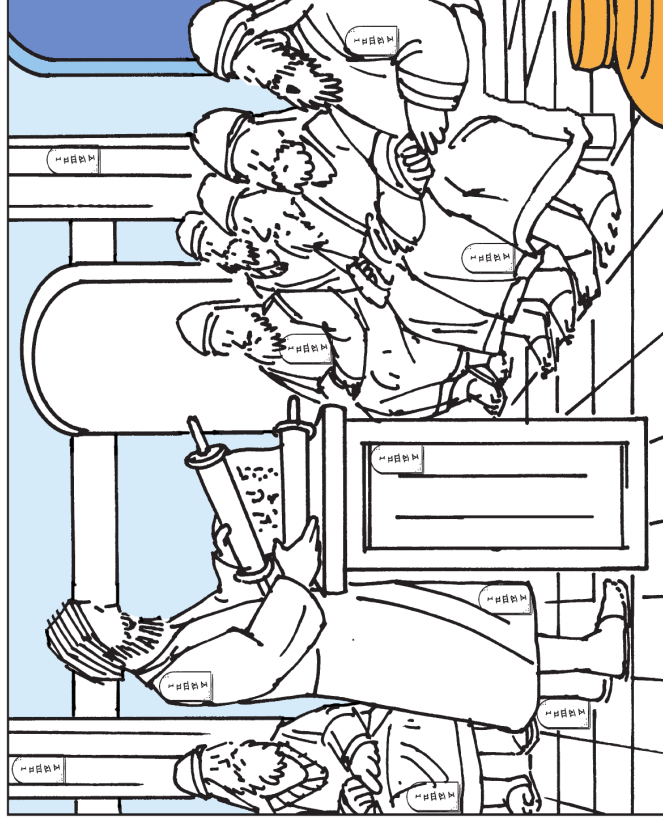
The Greatest Commandment

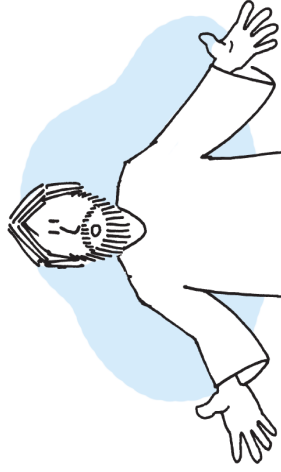

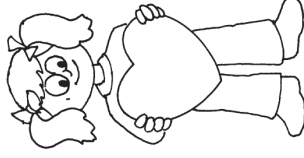

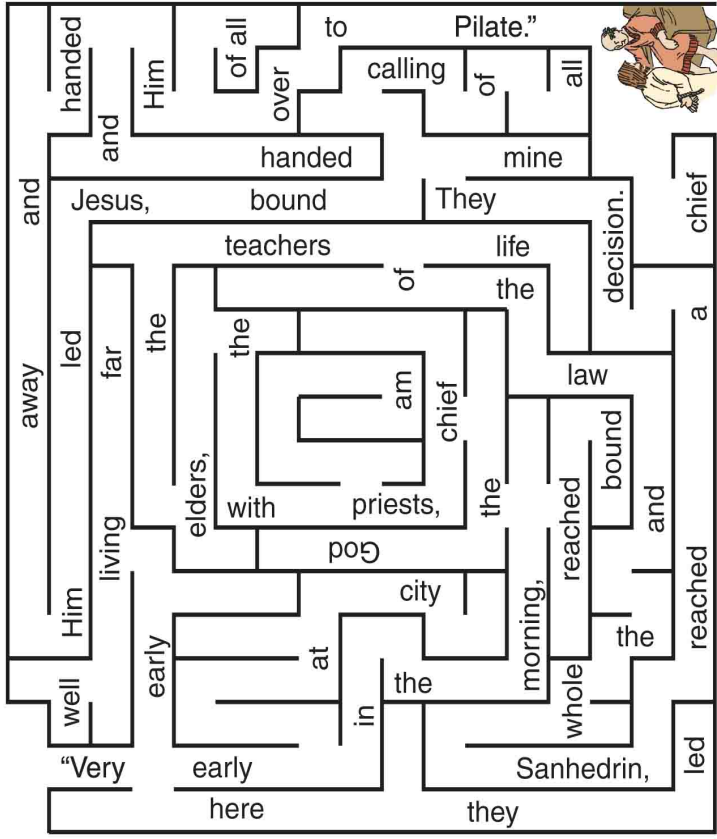
