

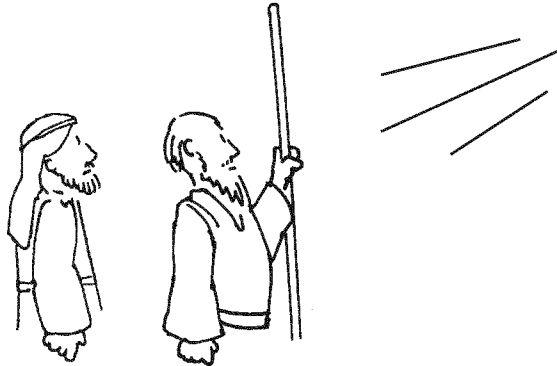


Moses said to the assembly,

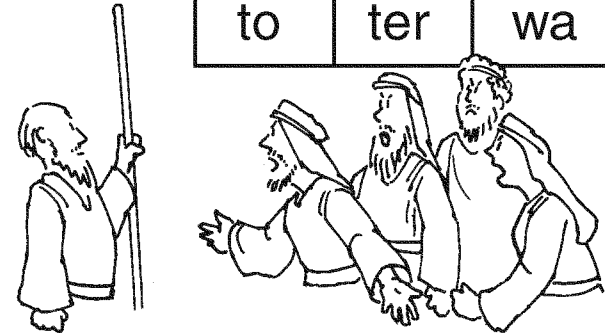

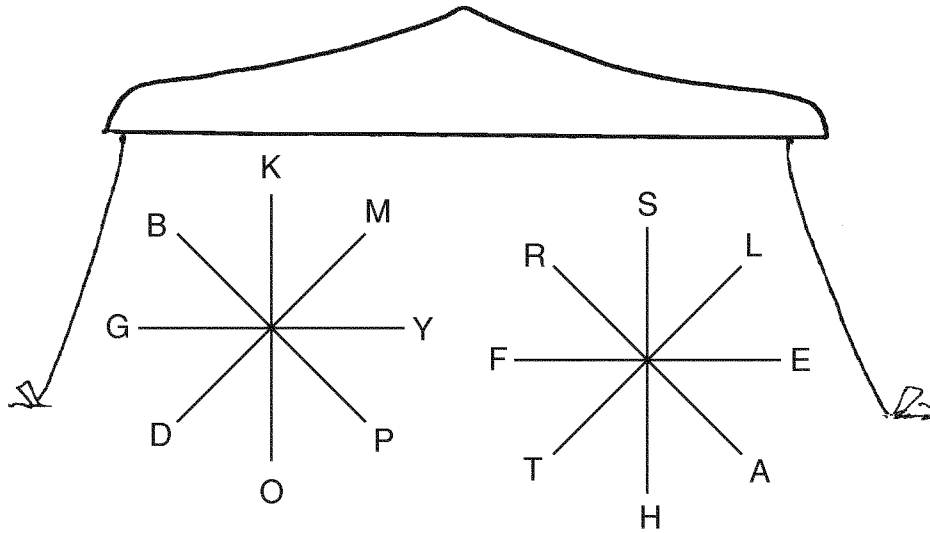

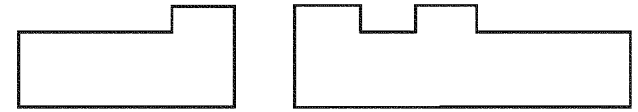
