



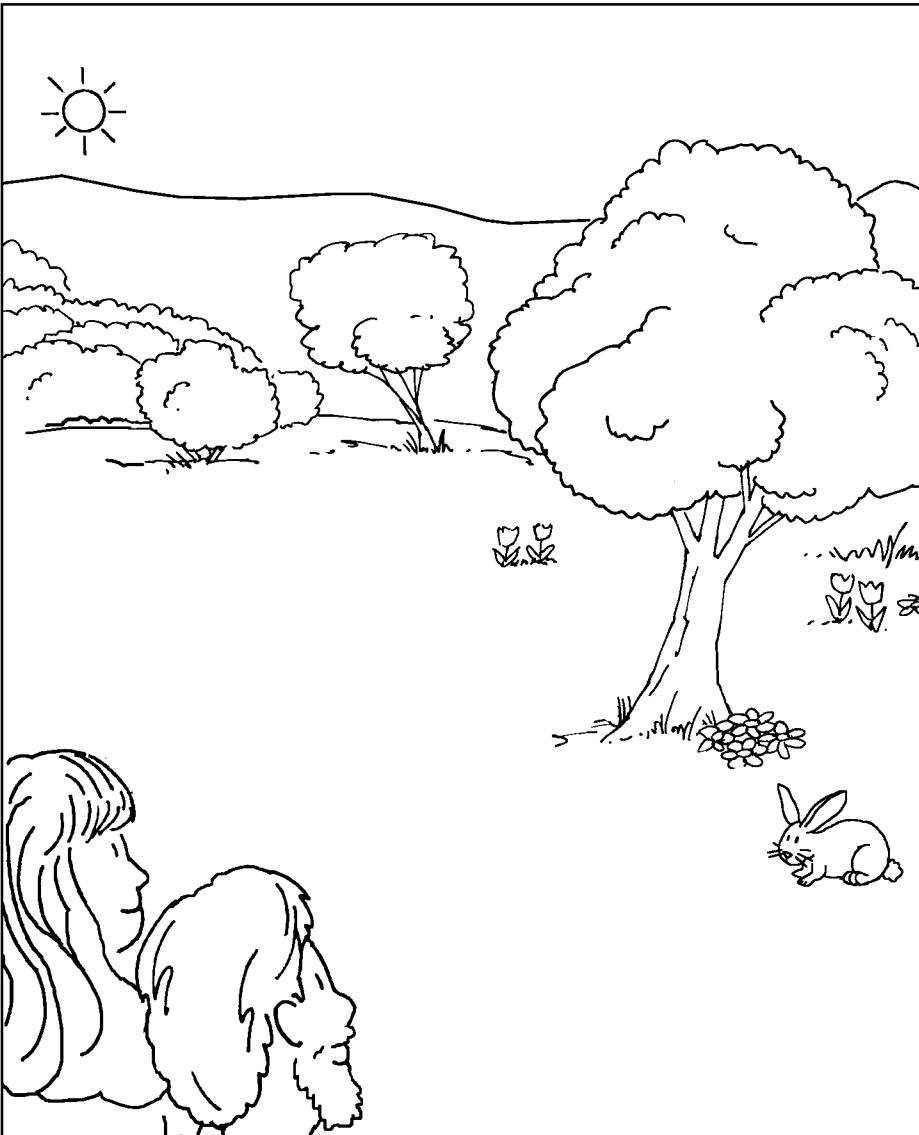

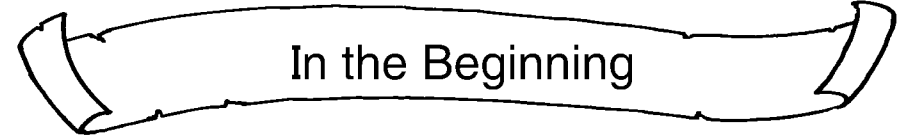

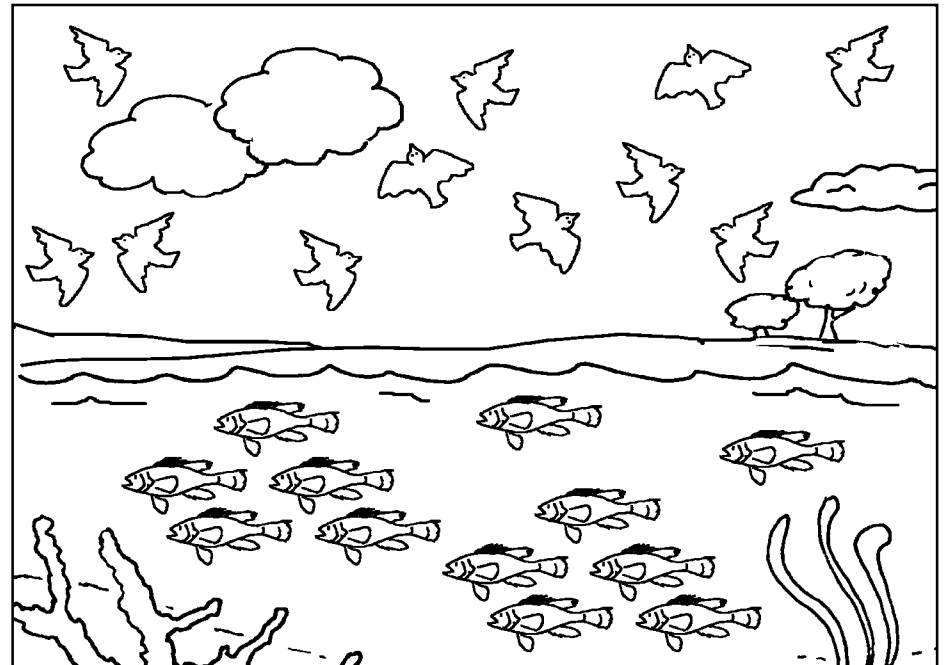

The Lord God created the earth and the heavens. He created all that is in them.

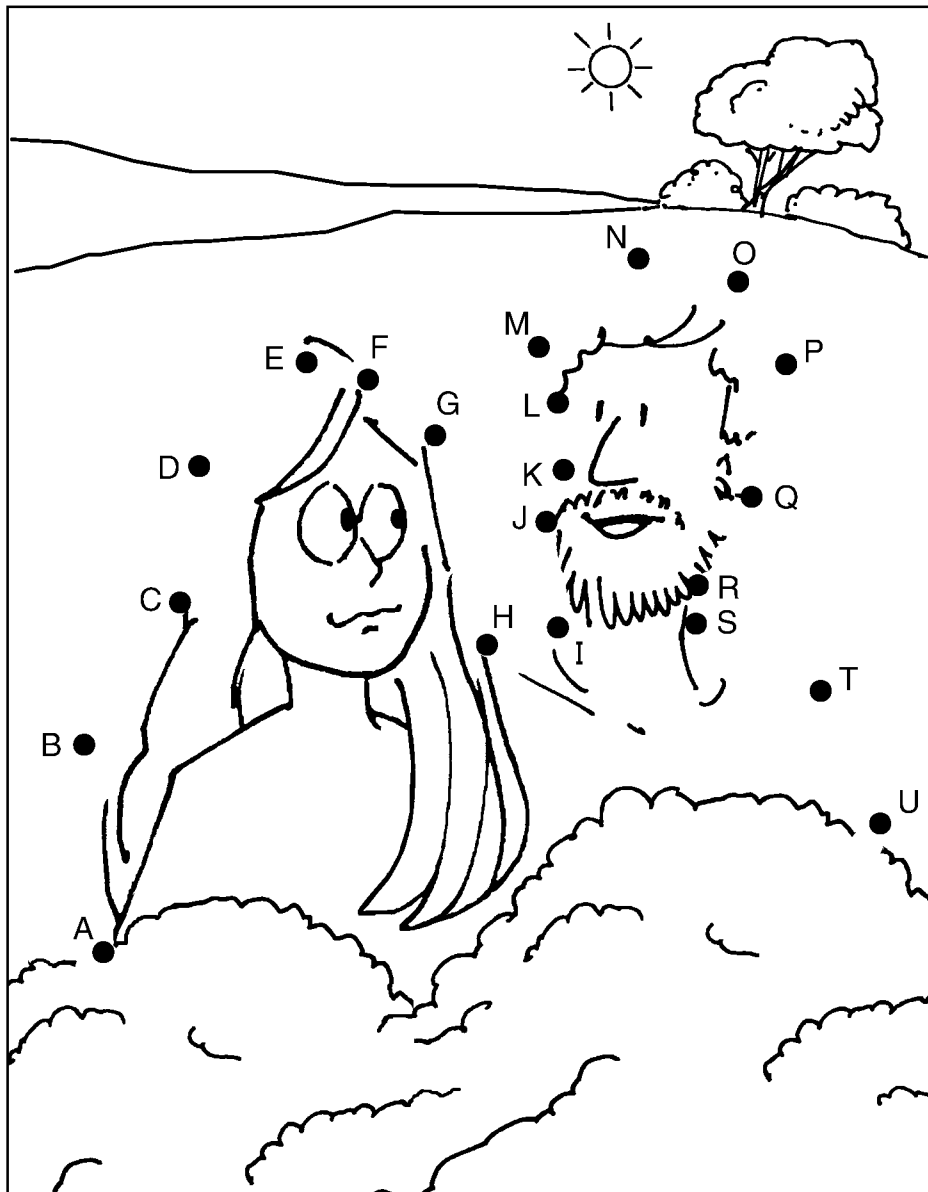

**Lottie** reminds us that people in the Old Testament were looking forward to the coming of the Lamb of God—Jesus—who takes away the sin of the world.

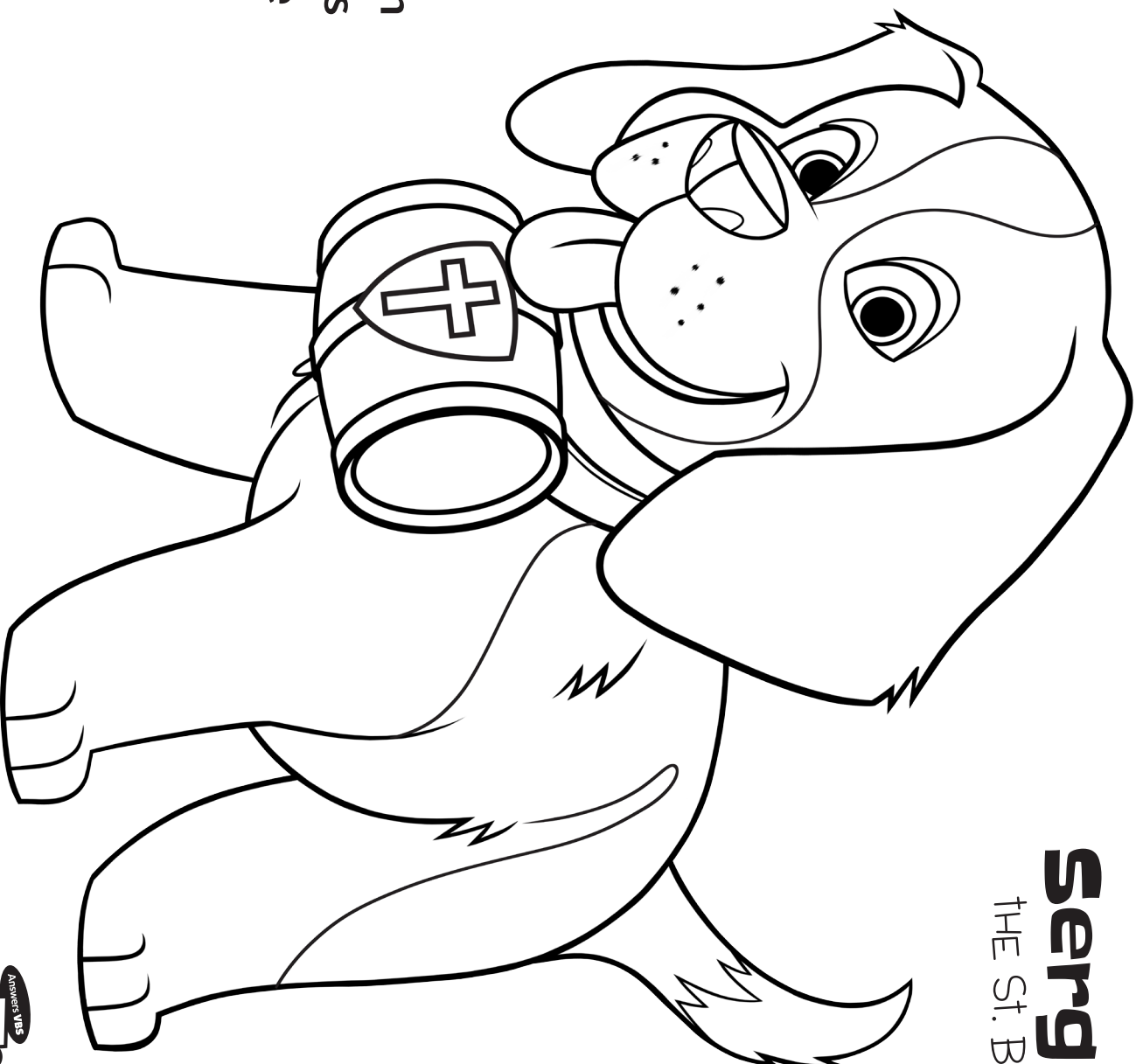

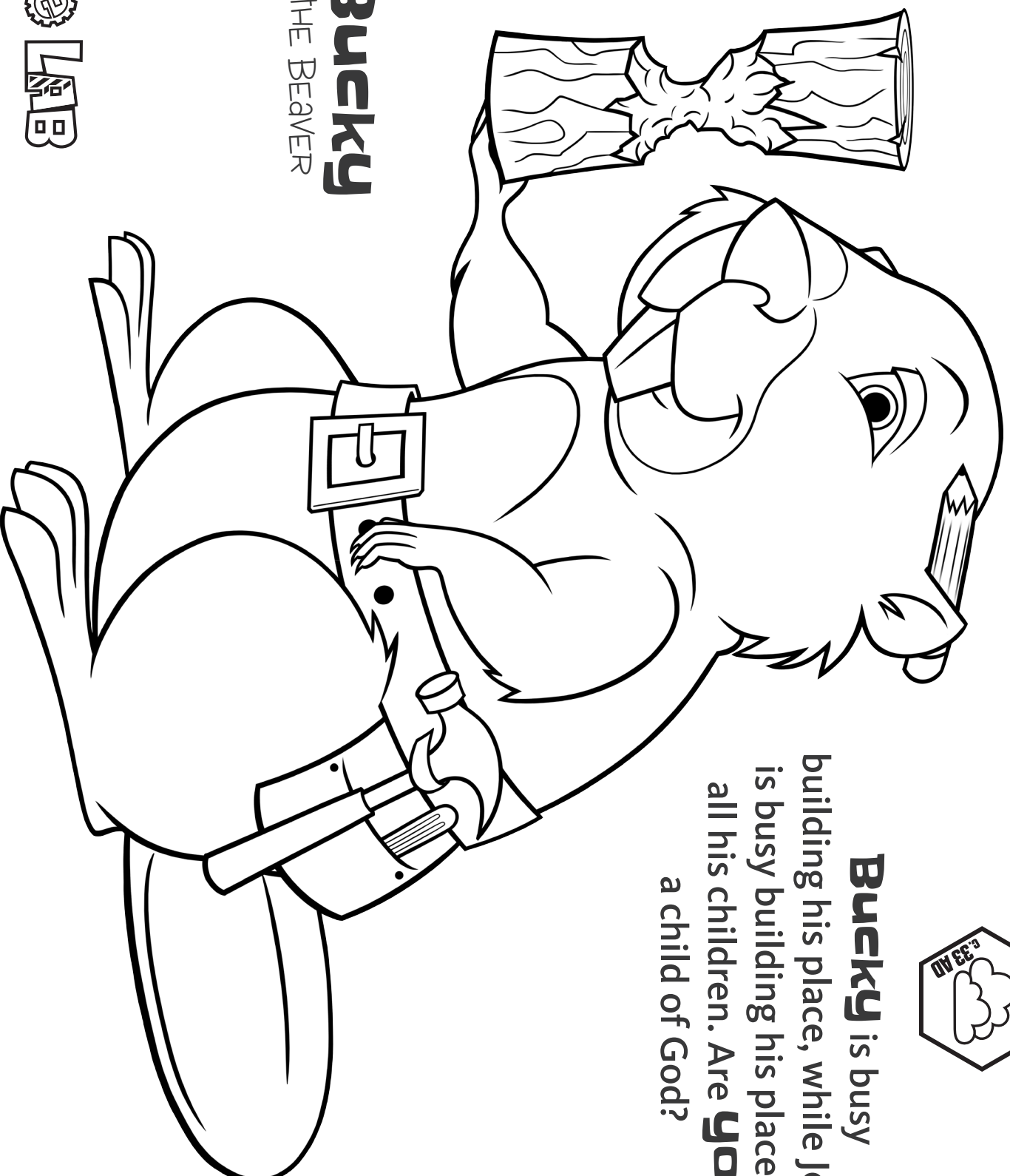


## Sergeant
