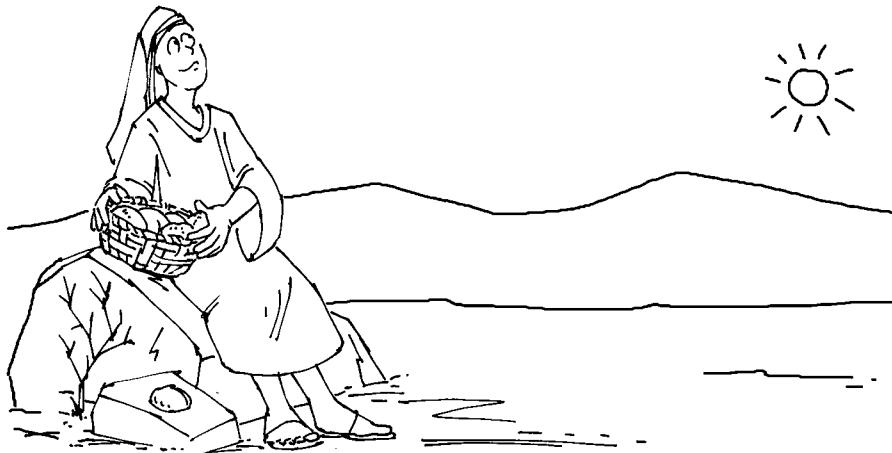

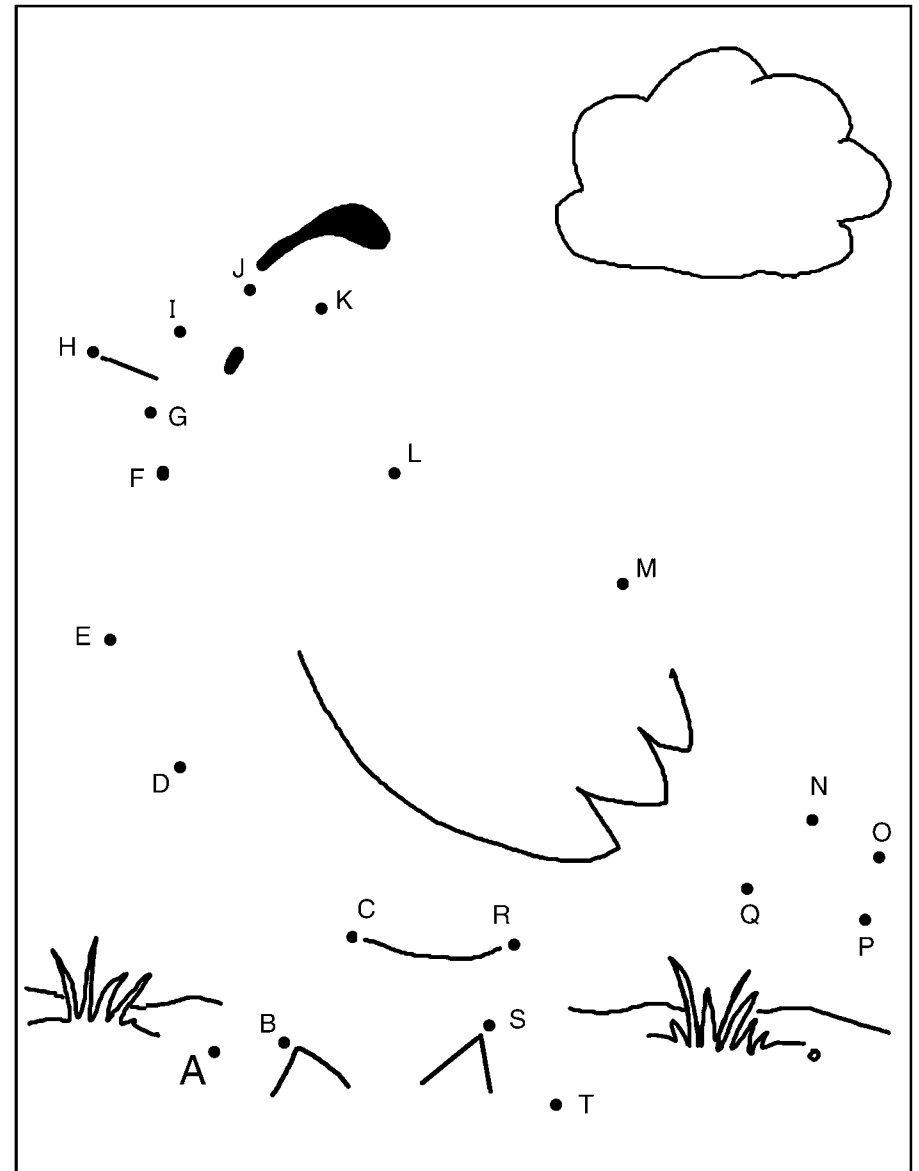

Print your choice of color or black & white 'plate' covering on pages 2-3. Cut and glue to a paper plate.

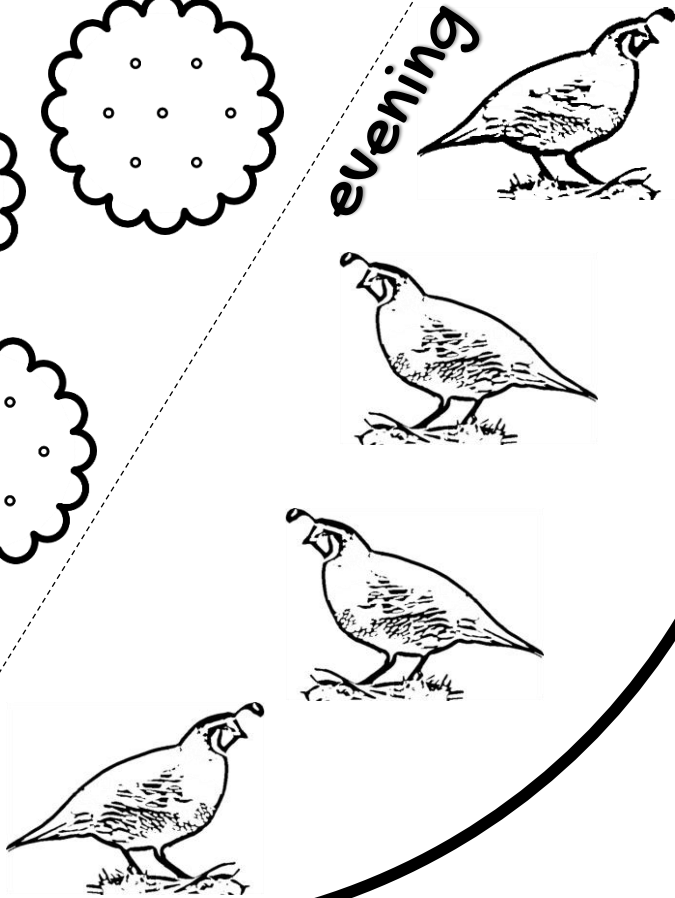
