**I am so thankful for who you are and what you have done for me.**

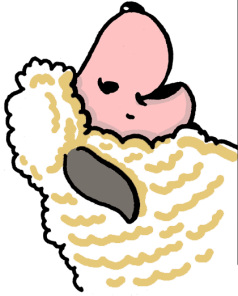
**I want to remember this passion week, the love and the suffering that you endured. You walked the life of faith and obedience to the Father. Help me to think about the pain and the death that you endured.**
