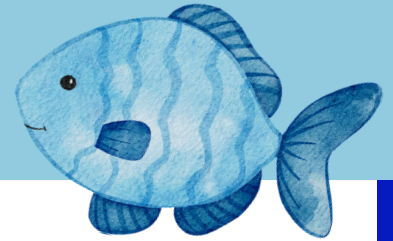

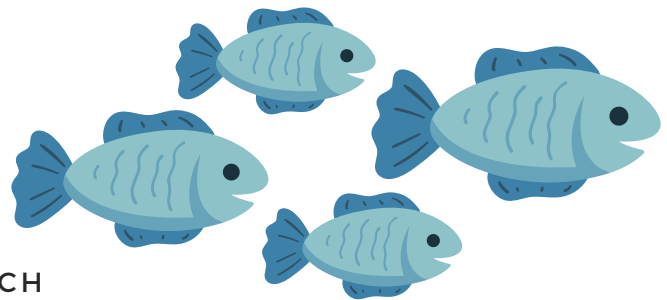

Bible Lesson

GENTILES BECAME PART OF THE CHURCH ACTS 11

God had called Peter to tell everyone the good news about Jesus, no matter who they were or where they came from. So Peter shared the gospel not only with Jews, but with Gentiles. Gentiles were the people who were not Jews. Jews thought they were the only chosen people by God to be saved but Jesus died for everyone!

The Gentiles in Caesarea heard Peter's message and believed in Jesus. God gave His Holy Spirit to these new believers, and they were baptized. Peter explained to the believers that the gospel is for all people. Then the believers praised God and understood that Jesus had come and died for the Gentiles, too! Some believers from Cyprus and Cyrene went to Antioch and preached the gospel to the Greeks, too. God was with them, and a large number of the Greeks believed the good news.



The church at Jerusalem sent Barnabas to Antioch. Barnabas was a good man. He loved God. When Barnabas arrived, he encouraged them to keep following God. Barnabas and Paul stayed with the church in Antioch for a year, teaching large crowds of people. Jesus' followers were first called Christians at Antioch.
