Bible Lesson

PAUL AND SILAS PRAISED IN JAIL ACTS 15-18

Paul and his friends Silas and Timothy traveled together and shared the gospel. One day, a servant girl met Paul and Silas. She had an evil spirit in her. Her owner would make money because the evil spirit in her will tell people what is going to happen in the future. Paul turned and said to the spirit in her, "I command you in the name of Jesus to come out of her!" And the spirit came out right away.

Now the girl's owners were upset because she could no longer make money for them. They grabbed Paul and Silas and put them in jail. About midnight, Paul and Silas were praying and singing songs to God. Suddenly, an earthquake shook the jail. The doors flew open, and all the prisoners' chains came loose.
