Bible Lesson

JESUS FED MANY PEOPLE MATTHEW 15

Jesus had been traveling with His disciples in an area where Gentiles—or non-Jews—lived. He healed people and taught people about God. Jesus looked at a large crowd of people and had compassion on them. They had been with Jesus for three days, and some had come a long distance to meet Him. They had nothing to eat.

Jesus told His disciples, "If I send them home, they will collapse on their way."

The disciples said, "We are not near a city. Where can we get enough bread to feed them?"

Jesus asked, "How many loaves of bread do you have?"

The disciples answered, "Seven."

Jesus told all the people to sit down. He took the seven loaves, gave thanks to God, and broke the bread into pieces. He gave the bread to His disciples to serve to the crowd. The disciples also had a few small fish, so Jesus blessed the fish and served them too.

Everyone ate and was satisfied. The disciples collected seven baskets full of leftover pieces. Jesus told the crowd—four thousand men plus women and children—to go home. Then Jesus and His disciples got into a boat and left that place.
