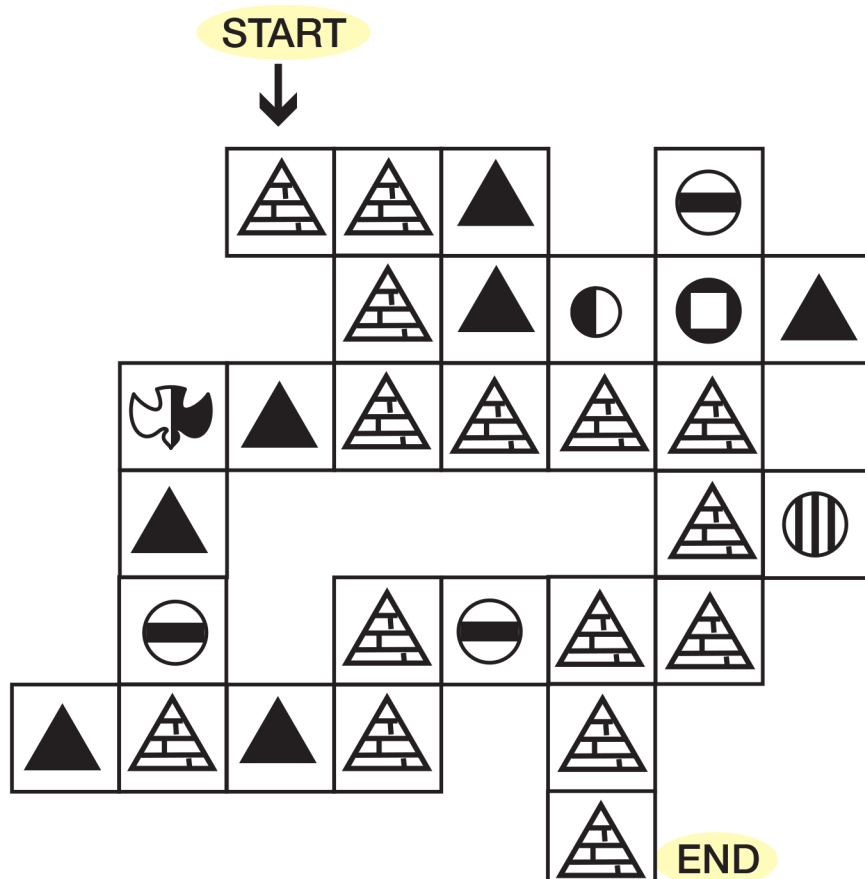

and became his attendant.

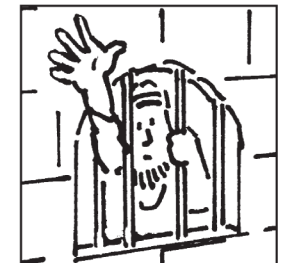
Follow the  through the maze.
